🍁 Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) / Automated External Defibrillation (AED)

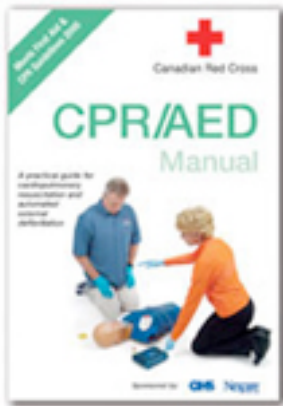
CPR Level A (Adult - 1 & 2 rescuers) / AED Level 2 (Onsite AED)

CPR/AED training: approx. 5.5 hours to complete*

(e.g. 8:30 am - 1:30 pm) - (Best practice - Expires after 1 year; good for 3 years – Recert. 4 hours only)

* CPR Certification to the new 2005 ILCOR (International Liaison Committee On Resuscitation) guidelines is required before doing the AED training. CPR certification usually takes place in the morning and requires approx. 3.5 to 4 hours to complete)

Compulsory Lessons: Course includes the following modules:



1. **Emergency Scene Management** (e.g. scene safety, 911, Primary Survey, etc.)
2. **Shock, Unconsciousness and Fainting** (e.g. Recovery position, "Jean pull, shock position, semi sitting and supported etc.)
